Technical teams from INTI around Argentina are developing low-cost ventilators and designing technical pieces that can be printed in 3D, working corroboratively with the private sector and other public institutions at a regional level. INTI is also providing technical assistance to teams from leading companies from the automotive sector and the chamber of commerce that are developing assisted breathing devices.

In addition to the above, INTI is testing 100 thousand non-contact thermometers in the San Luis Province, is working towards producing gel alcohol for the national health system, as well as manufacturing protective garments with textile coops.
