ImagineLab, a business incubator and accelerator based in Chile, launched a mentoring network for early stage tech-based startups to help them scaleup and develop their business in Chile. The virtual mentoring program offers a sector benchmark assessment, access to trainings and connections with potential investors, a digital platform to schedule virtual meetings, and the possibility to be part of the Microsoft for Start Ups Program.

The mentoring network seeks to help entrepreneurs to adapt to the challenges of COVID-19 that are impacting the economy. The network has more than 90 mentors with diverse backgrounds.

What support does the initiative needs?

ImagineLab is interested in funding to scale the mentoring virtual program to Latin America with digital tools to reach as many SME's and startups as possible.
