The Government of Chile announced a comprehensive emergency plan to help protect jobs and SMEs to mitigate the economic impact of Covid-19. The plan is comprised of the following strategies:

- Health system: Allocating additional funds to strengthen the health system;
- Securing labor and income: Protecting jobs of those who cannot telecommute but need to stay at home due to a government order, provide direct subsidy payments for workers of the informal economy, and create a solidary fund to alleviate social impacts; and
- Business promotion: Granting tax exceptions and temporarily suspension of collection of several tax items, accelerating payment of government's providers.
