The Center of Biologic Research of Northeast (CIBNOR) is working in five projects to help mitigate the Covid-19 pandemic. The projects include (i) quick low-cost diagnostic test; (ii) non-invasive ventilators; (iii) in-vitro probes to boost the immune system; (iv) environmental research to identity virus presence in the air; and (v) agro technologies to support rural economies.
