The Technology Transfer Network of Mexico (RED OTT), along with other partners from the private, public and academic sectors, launched an open innovation platform to address Covid-19 impacts on health systems, social distancing, and SMEs, and education. The platform will compile and share call for proposals launched by different institutions, as well as initiatives that have been developed to address the challenges that emerged with the pandemic.

The name of the platform is "Covid-19 Challenge Mexico". The main subjects covered in the platform are: (i) health, including health system and infrastructure and medicines; (ii) education, to facilitate digital education tools; (iii) community, comprising initiatives to help and support vulnerable communities; and (iv) businesses, with a special focus on SMEs and certain segments, such as food and beverages, retail, tourism, among others.


