Telemedicine Services Through Video Call to Optimize the Triage Process of Potential COVID-19 Patients in Peru

SmartDoctor, a HealthTech startup based in Peru, entered into a public-private partnership with the Ministry of Health of Peru and the Business Association of Pharmaceutical Laboratories (ALAFARPE) to offer remote services to optimize the triage process of potential COVID-19 patients and help determining the probability of disease in the population. SmartDoctor also provides medical orientation on pre-existing diseases and psychological/emotional support to help people manage anxiety and stress generated due to social isolation.

The health services are provided through SmartDoctor's platform via video calls, which are optimized with geolocation to provide medical and location monitoring for COVID-19 patients who must stay isolated at home.
