Digital Platform That Centralizes Information About Medical Devices to Treat COVID-19 Patients

The United States-Mexico Foundation for Science - FUMEC launched a virtual repository that centralizes technical information about medical devices developed to treat COVID-19 patients. The platform has a particular focus on different types of ventilators, following the policies established by the Mexican Health Authority to acquire and manufacture ventilators. The information available on the platform includes blueprints and licenses to build ventilators, research pieces on ventilators, among other valuable information.

Moreover, FUMEC joined the initiative called *Aditiva por Mexico*, which gathers experts on 3D printing. The initiative seeks to use 3D printing technologies for expedited manufacturing of parts of medical devices to treat COVID-19 patients and personal protective equipment for health professionals.
