The High-Level Commission for the Prevention and Control of Coronavirus launched a program to support independent workers called Pa' Ti (For U). The program aims to provide monthly financial support to independent workers that have not been able to operate due to social distancing measures implemented to contain the spread of the coronavirus.

The Ministry of Finance created a web portal for independent workers to confirm the eligibility to receive the financial support. The criteria for eligibility include several requirements from having an active bank account to not benefit from other government business support programs.
