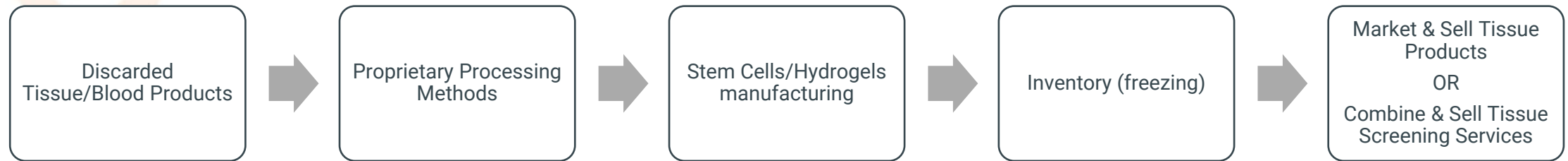
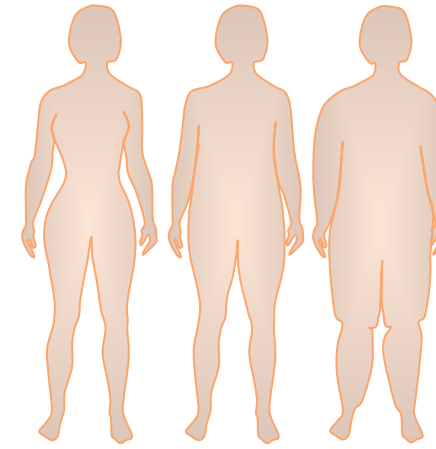
Our research has resulted in a 3-dimensional culture, which allows for more accurate models of human tissue in its diseased state compared to traditional 2-dimensional culture.

Our Process

Building Tissue Requires **Stem Cells, Media, and Hydrogels**



- **LOW COGS:** We recycle discarded medical waste from plastic surgical and orthopedic procedures.
- **REGULATORY PROCESS:** We receive these tissues under approved Western Institutional Review Board or exempt protocols, or from AABB processes.
- **UNIQUE:** We retain the demographic information of the donors for our biobank,.
